Details of the claim, that is to say a statement of the material facts on which the Claimant relies, must be attached to this Cause Form. A copy of the Cause Form, after it has been stamped by HM Sergeant to confirm that it has been served on the Defendant, must be filed at the Greffe not later than 4 p.m. on the Wednesday prior to the Friday on which the Summons is returnable before the Royal Court. The minimum Court Fee of £176 (or £231 in the case of an eviction involving domestic premises only) must be paid at the same time. (2)

- (1) The Claimant must state his/her address for service, that is to say the address at which any document may be validly served.
