The Royal Court (Costs and Fees)

(Amendment) Rules, 2023

THE ROYAL COURT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 1 of the Royal Court (Costs and Fees) (Guernsey) Law, 1969^a, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of the principal Rules.

- (1) The Royal Court (Costs and Fees) Rules, 2012^b ("the principal
 Rules") are amended as follows.
 - (2) In Rule 2—
 - (a) in paragraph (2), for "£268" substitute "£325", and
 - (b) in paragraph (3), for "2020" substitute "2025".
- (3) For the Schedule to the principal Rules, substitute the Schedule to these Rules.

2. The principal Rules, as amended by these Rules, have effect in relation to fees payable in respect of a proceeding or matter –
